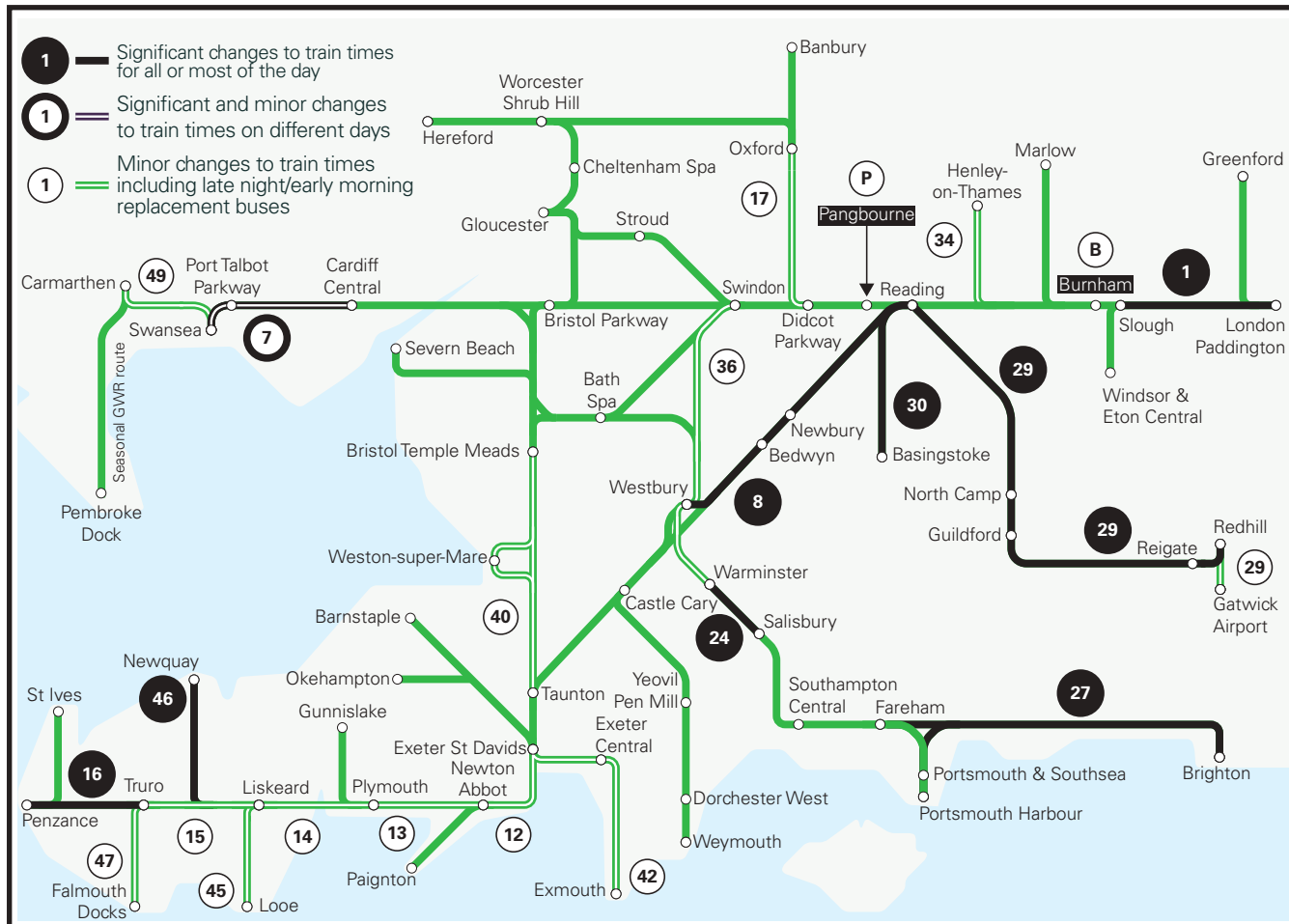


# Summary of timetable changes

## Saturday 12 to Friday 18 March 2022

- 
- ① **Sunday until approximately 0745** - Some local trains between London Paddington and Reading will be slightly retimed, in some cases, EARLIER than usual. Some trains will be replaced by buses between Slough and London Paddington.
- 
- ① **Sunday until approximately 1800** - Most High Speed services will depart up to 8 minutes EARLIER from London Paddington. Most stopping trains between London Paddington and Reading will not run between London Paddington and Slough in both directions.
- 
- ⑦ **Sunday - Until approximately 1730**, buses will replace trains between Cardiff Central and Swansea. **From approximately 1730**, buses will replace trains between Port Talbot Parkway, Neath and Swansea.
- 
- ⑦ **Monday to Thursday** - The 2148 & 2248 London Paddington to Swansea will run later from Bridgend to Swansea.
- 
- ⑧ **All weekend** - Long-distance services will be diverted and will not call at Newbury or Pewsey. Some trains will call additionally at Swindon for bus connections to/from Pewsey. A revised train service will run between Reading and Newbury. Buses will run between Newbury and Bedwyn.
- 
- ⑫ ⑬ **Monday to Thursday** - The 2202 London Paddington to Plymouth will terminate at Exeter St Davids. A bus will run from Exeter St Davids to Plymouth. The Night Riviera Sleeper will not run in either direction.
- 
- ⑭ ⑮ **All weekend** - Buses will replace trains between Truro and Penzance. A reduced train service will run between Plymouth and Truro.
- 
- ⑯ **Sunday** - The 2145 Penzance to London Paddington will start from Truro. A bus connection will run from Penzance.
- 
- ⑰ **Sunday** - Most trains from Oxford to London Paddington will depart Oxford a few minutes later than usual.
- 
- ⑰ **From approximately 2345 Monday to Thursday until 0400 next day** - Trains will be retimed by a few minutes, or will be replaced by buses between Didcot Parkway and Oxford.
- 
- ⑳ **All weekend** - Buses will replace trains between Warminster and Salisbury. A few trains will also not run between Westbury and Warminster. Other trains will call additionally at Dilton Marsh.
- 
- ㉑ **All weekend** - GWR services to/from Brighton will not run. Passengers should use other operators' services, changing where necessary. GWR tickets will be valid.
- 
- ㉒ **Saturday** - The 2334 Reading to Gatwick Airport will terminate at Redhill. A bus will run from Redhill to Gatwick Airport.
- 
- ㉓ **Sunday** - A reduced hourly service will run between Reading and Guildford. Buses will run between Guildford and Redhill / Gatwick Airport.
- 
- ㉔ **Sunday** - All day, buses will replace trains between Reading and Basingstoke.
- 
- ㉕ **Tuesday to Friday** - The 0018 Henley-on-Thames to Reading will terminate at Twyford. An alternative rail connection will run from Twyford to Reading.
- 
- ㉖ **All weekend** - Long-distance services that would normally run via Newbury will instead run via Swindon. Some local trains between Westbury and Swindon via Melksham will be retimed as a result.

## Saturday 12 to Friday 18 March 2022

---

**Sunday** - The 0800 Bristol Temple Meads to Penzance (terminating at St Austell) and the 0759 Exeter St Davids to Bristol Temple Meads will be replaced by a bus between Weston-super-Mare and Taunton.

④① **Monday to Thursday from approximately 2030 until end of service** - Trains will divert to run non-stop between Bristol Temple Meads and Taunton. Additional trains will run between Bristol Temple Meads and Weston-super-Mare, connecting with buses running between Weston-super-Mare and Taunton.

④② **Monday to Wednesday from approximately 2330 until 0600 next day** - Trains to and from Exmouth will be replaced by buses between Exeter St Davids and Exmouth.

④⑤ **Saturday** - Some trains between Liskeard and Looe will be slightly retimed to maintain connections into/out of retimed Mainline services at Liskeard.

④⑥ **All weekend** - Some trains between Par and Newquay will be retimed, in some cases EARLIER, to maintain connections into/out of retimed Mainline services at Par.

④⑦ **All weekend** - Some trains between Truro and Falmouth Docks will be retimed to maintain connections into/out of retimed Mainline services at Truro.

④⑨ **Sunday** - Most GWR services to and from Carmarthen will not run. Passengers should use alternative TfW services.

**Saturday** - The 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington will not call at Taplow or Burnham. Buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.

Ⓑ **Sunday until approximately 0800 and from approximately 2345 until end of service** - Trains will not call at Burnham. Buses will run between Slough and Burnham.

**Monday to Friday from approximately 2330 until end of service** - Trains will not call at Burnham or Taplow. Buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.

**Saturday** - The 0045 Oxford to Reading will not call at Pangbourne. Buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.

Ⓟ **Monday to Thursday from approximately 2330 until 0400 next day** - Trains will not call at Pangbourne. Buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.

**Friday** - The 2330 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway will not call at Pangbourne. Buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
